90 Signorello 2003 Seta White Wine (Napa Valley); \$25. A barrel-fermented blend of Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc, this is a great wine to drink with almost anything. It's stylishly dry and crisp with acids, with a creamy texture framing subtle flavors of lime, gooseberry and dried herbs. —S.H.

Gismondi On Wine

90/100 Signorello Seta 2003

Napa Valley, California, United States This wine has become consistently reliable over the years. Look for honey, vanilla, spicy fig, buttery, citrus, dry lees and mineral aromas. Dry, round, elegant style but rich with buttery fig, grapefruit, green melon, honey, vanilla and spicy lees flavours. A bit young at this point to be sipping but it does have fine concentration. It will definitely repay another year or two of bottle ageing in the cellar.
